

## Roam without paying roaming charges with an international SIM card.

Everyone who travels abroad has felt the pinch of high phone bills at one time or the other. Your local mobile service provider has provided you a card to use with the local network. The moment you go overseas and away from the local network, you have to pay a special charge even for incoming calls. Generally the provider of the foreign country imposes a termination charge on the incoming calls to their network and this has to be borne by the foreign network.

While most networks have an understanding and do help to cut down each others termination charge, some charges are still applied and these are passed on to the customer, which is you. By using an international SIM card, you can avoid all these costs. Since these cards are generally of the network of the country you are visiting, all the local calls you make while on your overseas trip are charged at local call rates.

With your original SIM card, even a local call made in the country you are visiting would be treated as an international call, since the call is routed through your home service provider's network back to the local network. If you thought that going in for a international SIM card includes lots of paperwork and other headaches, you are wrong. There are no papers to sign up and you can get the card delivered to your residence in a few days from the time you place your order.

Receiving the international SIM card before you embark on your overseas trip means that you can inform your friends and relatives about your new number while at home. You do not have to make expensive overseas calls and this in itself saves you a good sum of money. It is obvious that while you are on a business trip, you will have to make local calls in your country of destination. Since the SIM is a local one, you just pay local rates.

The calls you receive from your friends and relatives are not charged for and the overseas calls you make too will cost you far less than what it might have cost you from your normal SIM card. Whichever way you look at it, you end up a winner. As the countless people who have been using these international SIM card and they will tell you of the substantial savings they make on each trip.

All that is required is an unlocked GSM set and if you do not have the same, the card providers will arrange that too for a nominal charge. It is high time that you too joined this trend of calling international but paying for local. This is the best way to make calls while on an overseas trip. The validity of the card is generally for 60 days, but can be extended for up to one year for a nominal extra charge.
